ORDINANCE NO. 2026-07

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHANGE IN WATER RATES OF THE VILLAGE OF DONNELLSON, BOND COUNTY AND MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-139-8 of the Illinois Municipal Code (the "Code"), the Village of Donnellson (the "Village") is authorized to set rates and charges for both waterworks and sewage systems; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality is a non-home-rule unit of local government and may exercise only those powers granted by the Illinois Constitution and statutes, including the powers granted under the Code; and.

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities find it is in the best interests of the public health, safety, and welfare of the Municipality to amend the Utilities Code as set forth in this Ordinance, include to increase the water rates and to make related administrative and conforming changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board of the Village of Donnellson, Bond County and Montgomery County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Utilities Ordinance 38-4-10, entitled "Water Rates," is hereby amended as follows (additions **bold/underlined**; deletions ~~stricken~~):

(A) Water Rates Inside Village.

First 1,000 gallons per month ~~\$24.73~~ **25.47** Minimum Charge

Over 1,000 gallons per month ~~\$17.83~~ **20.50** per 1,000 gallons

(B) Water Rates Outside of Village.

First 1,000 gallons per month ~~\$28.45~~ **29.30** Minimum Charge

Over 1,000 gallons per month ~~\$19.17~~ **22.05** per 1,000 gallons

SECTION 2: All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be codified in the Revised Code of Ordinances of Donnellson, Illinois, and the Village Clerk is authorized to make any non-substantive formatting, numbering, and cross-reference changes necessary to implement codification.
