The Village of Donnellson will hold a public meeting on Monday, September 12, 2022 at 6:45 p.m., at Village Hall located at 407 Jefferson, Donnellson, IL 62019 to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their views on the proposed federally funded Pedestrian Facilities Improvements project. The project consists of the replacement of existing sidewalks with ADA-compliant sidewalk and pedestrian lighting. The project area will encompass Route 127 (from Dollar General to Union St.), Carson St. (from Route 127 to Jefferson St.), North St. (from the east end to Jefferson St.), Union St. (from Route 127 to Jefferson St.), and Jefferson St. (from Carson St. to Union St.). The Village of Donnellson intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Transportation for a grant through the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program – Cycle 15.
