Roll Call Completed:

Meeting Minutes:

- Gary Long made a motion to accept the minutes of the July 11, 2022 meeting. Fran Jett seconded the motion. All were in favor.

- Gary Long made a motion to bypass the purchase of a cd this month. It was seconded by David Buckingham. It passed with all ayes.
