ORDINANCE NO. 2026-01

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES BY THE VILLAGE OF DONNELLSON, BOND COUNTY AND MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-76.1-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the Village of Donnellson (the "Village") is authorized to purchase real property for public purposes; and

WHEREAS, Frances A. Jett ("Seller") is the owner in fee simple of property commonly known as 105 West Hampton Street, Donnellson, Montgomery County, Illinois, PIN: 20-24-483-001 (the "Property").

WHEREAS, the Village intends to purchase the Property, adjacent to the Village's water tower, for the purposes of improvements to the Village's water and sewer systems.

WHEREAS, the Village President of the Village of Donnellson (the "President") and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Donnellson (the "Village Board" and with the President, the "Corporate Authorities") have determined that it is advisable, and in the best interest of the Village to enter an agreement for the purchase of the Property.

WHEREAS, the Village has a provisional offer to purchase the Property at a price of \$10,000 subject to approval of this Ordinance and the execution of a Real Estate Purchase Agreement.

WHEREAS, the President is authorized to enter into and the Village Attorney is authorized to revise agreements for the Village making such insertions, omissions, and changes as shall be approved by the President and the Village Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Board of the Village of Donnellson, Bond County and Montgomery County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the President be authorized to execute the purchase of the Property with terms substantially the same as the provisional offer.

SECTION 2: That the President be hereby authorized to execute all documents and do all things necessary and essentials, including execution of any documents and certificates to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance and purchase of the Property.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
